I'm Not Myself At All, delves into the world of Canadian art and provides an important analysis of the way women's understanding of the self is shaped through various media.



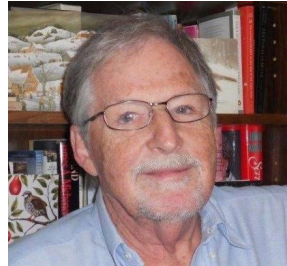
